We start with a moment of silence, followed by the Serenity Prayer.

May we hear "How It Works" and the "Twelve Steps of S.A.A.?"

Would someone please read the "Abstinence Statement?"

May we hear the "S.A.A. Traditions" of the week? (1 thru 3 on the first week in the month, etc.)

It is the custom of this group to welcome newcomers. A newcomer is anyone in the first twenty-four hours to thirty days of sobriety from inner circle behavior. We don't do this to embarrass you, but so that we can get to know you and perhaps talk after the meeting. Are there any newcomers?

Are there any visitors or people at this meeting for the first time?

This is a Big Book Step Study meeting. Each week, we read a step or part of a step and then open the meeting up for discussion.
